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2020-2021 Attendance Acknowledgement and Disclosure for Parents/Guardians during the COVID-19 Health Emergency

Please read and initial each statement below.

- _____ I understand that to enter the school building, my child must be free from these four main COVID-19 symptoms: *Fever of 100°+ F, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, New loss of smell, New cough*
- _____ I understand that my child's temperature will be taken upon arrival and register below 100° F before proceeding into the school building.
- _____ I understand that LSFB will follow the CDC, NY state and local health agencies' guidelines regarding face coverings for every individual to enter and while in the building.
- _____ I understand I must practice social distancing and remain 6 feet from those that are not in my family.
- _____ I understand that my child will be directed to use hand sanitizer before proceeding into the classroom areas of the school.
- _____ I understand that only one adult is permitted to walk to the entrance of the building where he/she will be received by a staff member. I will not be allowed to enter the building to drop off or pick up my child.
- _____ I understand that during this time of COVID-19 Health Emergency, I will not be permitted to enter the building, except to visit the office, beyond the designated drop off and pick up areas. I understand that this is to limit the extent of possible risk of exposure for all.
- _____ I understand that in the case of a NON-COVID-19 Illness, my child will need to be symptom-free and fever free without any medication for 72 hours.
- _____ I understand that in the case of COVID-19 Illness in My Home, my child will be quarantined at home for 14 days and must be symptom free without any medications for 72 hours.

_____ I understand that if my child's in-building instruction is canceled (due to the health department or governor closure) or if he/she is absent, Remote Learning using Class DOJO or Google Classroom, which will be set up at the beginning of the school year, will be used to provide and continue instruction.

_____ I understand that I will immediately notify the school if I become aware of any person with whom my child or I have had contact exhibits any of the symptoms listed above, is advised to quarantine, has tested positive, or is presumed positive for COVID-19.

_____ I understand that I need to have an emergency contact for my child if he/she becomes ill that can get to the school within 30 minutes of us being notified for pick up.

_____ I understand that it is my responsibility to inform any adult contact and/or emergency contact person(s) of the information contained in this agreement.

_____ I understand that while present in the school building each day my child will be in contact with children and staff who are all at risk for community exposure. I understand that no list of restrictions, guidelines or practices will remove 100% of the risk exposure to COVID-19 as a person who is asymptomatic could transmit the virus, but we are all trying to do the best at mitigating that risk. I understand that we all play a crucial role in keeping everyone as safe and healthy as possible.
